<u>Global Grants</u>

Criteria for Selection for D 6910

When considering the selection and funding of District Global Grants, the below criteria will be considered by the selection committee composed of the District Rotary Foundation Chair(DRFC), the District Rotary Service Chair(DRSC) and the District Global Grants Coordinator(DGGC). This committee will make recommendations to the District Governor for approval.

One Grant Typically

- Must serve one or more of Rotary's Six Areas of Focus.
- Must meet various "Sustainability" criteria.
- Is there evidence or assurance from the Host Club that the proposed project a priority for the benefiting community?
- Is there a positive track record of the Host Club with previous projects?
- Evidence that neither the Host Rotary Club nor the International Rotary Club have over due reports on previous projects.
- Can the international Rotary Club visit the location of the proposed project?
- Does the cooperating organization (if any) have a positive track record?
- Describe the potential conflict of interests.
- Outline the funding plan.
- How well acquainted are the Host Rotary Club and the International partners?
- How many beneficiaries are to be served?
- Are the beneficiaries involved in project planning?
- What are contingency plans?
- Both International/Host Clubs are Qualified with TRF
- A Global Grant Proposal Worksheet MUST be filled out & presented to the District before filing the Global Grant with RI.
